No extreme hair, finger nail, or make-up styles will be allowed on stage. Hair must not be in student's face – this applies to males and females. Front hairline can not be all the way to the eye – these results in your child's face being in a shadow during the performance and created constant as hair is moved for sight-line. If needed, hair accessories/product should be minimal and matte black finish – nothing obtrusive. Girls with longer hair will wear hair in a pony tail – if applicable, boys will do the same.

I believe that you will be pleased with the appearance of our students on stage. If there are personal issues with any of these suggestions, please contact me. However these have been discussed with various parent meetings already. If obtaining the recommended concert wear presents any problems (financial, religious etc.) please contact Mr. Firestone. This year we will use an internet company for concert wear to minimize time and financial concerns. Ladies who are entering the program this year will need the following items: Dress (This will be a Princess Line Dress in a black Satin. The dress will be sleeveless and will have a sweetheart neckline. Fitting ties will allow Ladies to adjust the waistline to their specific needs). The dresses are available in children sizes through misses sizes at: www.formalfashionsinc.com. The style is 3760 RA – we will be wearing black in the royal satin/shiny finish. Female students will also need to purchase faux pearl jewelry – necklaces and earrings. These are found cheapest at: www.ictuslimited.com under accessories. You will have the option to purchase the Faux Pearl necklace and earrings (pierced or clip on). This is also a great web location to buy shoes for the girls The Broadway Character Shoe is the preferred shoe for you to purchase. If size is an issue, you may purchase the Ballare shoe. (Black for either shoe style). However, similar shoes purchased at any location will be fine.
